The UGA Apprenticeship program is a four year program where glaziers will gain the skills and experience to be certified Journeymen Glaziers. The program includes three years of classroom education, each year comprised of two 16-week semesters with semiweekly evening classes. This program is an incredible opportunity for a glazier to advance his or her skills, gain nationally recognized credentials, and increase his or her pay. Leaders in the glazing industry of used apprenticeship programs to launch their careers, and aspiring leaders should view this opportunity to transform their job into a full-fledged career.

The apprenticeship classes will be held two evenings per week from 5:30-8:00PM.

The UGA Apprenticeship Program has three main focuses:

- 1. Proficiency in all trade skill areas of the glazing profession
- 2. Fluency in all safety topics relevant to the glazing industry
- 3. Aptitude in primary life skills that improve work-life, home life, and social life
